The goal of the education is learning about the world around us. The five senses are essential in collecting and understanding the information about our surroundings.



# MY FIVE SENSES



Students in the second grade learned what body parts relate to each of the five senses; how we use the five senses to discover new information; what words we use to describe various objects based on our five senses. Students participated in engaging activities when they had to identify the look, the sound, the smell, the feel and the taste of the selected objects. They played the role of texture scientists where they had to touch many things and use adjectives to describe how they feel. They also were asked to listen to various sounds and answer the question "What does it sound like?" To test their sense of smell students had to guess the familiar smell while being blindfolded.

Students learned a lot of sensory words through observation and conversation. Finally, they demonstrated increased cooperation and collaboration during the study process.
